

THE BARRACKS RECOVERY

HOUSE RULES AGREEMENT

The Barracks Recovery is a structured, sober, and accountability-focused environment. All residents must follow the rules below to maintain safety, respect, and a positive recovery community.

1. Sobriety Requirement

- Absolutely no drugs, alcohol, or mind-altering substances.
- No possession of paraphernalia.
- Random drug/alcohol testing is required at any time.
- Refusal or tampering is grounds for discharge.

2. Curfew & Attendance

- Residents must follow the posted curfew schedule.
- All overnights must be approved 24 hours in advance.
- Residents must attend required house meetings and recovery meetings weekly.

3. Respect & Conduct

- Treat all residents, staff, and property with respect.
- No violence, threats, harassment, or bullying.
- No stealing or borrowing personal items without permission.
- Keep language and behavior appropriate for a recovery environment.

4. Chores & Cleanliness

- Complete assigned daily and weekly chores.
- Keep personal space clean and orderly.
- Common areas must be kept clean at all times.

5. Employment & Daily Structure

- Residents must maintain employment, be actively seeking employment, or attend an approved program.
- Loitering, excessive sleeping, and lack of daily structure are not permitted.

6. Guests

- No guests allowed inside the home without staff approval.
- Romantic partners are not permitted on the property.

7. Medications

- All medications must be reported on the Medication Form.
- No narcotic or controlled medications unless pre-approved.
- Misuse or sharing of medication will result in discharge.

8. Safety & Property

- No weapons allowed on the property.
- Tampering with smoke detectors, cameras, or safety equipment is prohibited.
- Residents are responsible for any damages they cause.

9. Honesty & Accountability

- Residents are expected to be open, honest, and responsible in their recovery.
- Any dishonesty regarding substance use, curfew violations, or rule-breaking may result in sanctions or discharge.

10. Compliance

Failure to comply with these rules may result in consequences up to and including immediate discharge from The Barracks Recovery.
